Field activity of second year scholars as part of their Environmental Science subject.

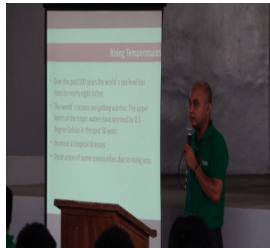
