



INVITATION TO BID FOR LABORATORY SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT

3. The Procuring Entity now invites bids for laboratory supplies and equipment.¹ Delivery of the Goods is required in **sixty (60) calendar days**. Bidders should have completed, within two (2) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.

4. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”.

Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183.

5. Interested bidders may obtain further information from **Philippine Science High School-Bicol Region Campus** and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from **8:00 AM to 5:00 PM**.

6. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on March 13, 2017 from the address below upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of **five thousand (P5,000.00) pesos**.

7. The *Procuring Entity* will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on March 20, 2017, 10:00 o'clock in the morning at the Seminar Hall, Admin Bldg, PSHS-BRC, Tagongtong, Goa, Camarines Sur which shall be open to prospective bidders.

8. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat at the address below on or before **April 3, 2017, at 10:00 o'clock in the morning**. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB Clause Error! Reference source not found.**

Bid opening shall be on **April 3, 2017, at 10:05 o'clock in the morning at the Seminar Hall, Admin Bldg, PSHS-BRC, Tagongtong, Goa, Camarines Sur**. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders’ representatives who choose to attend at the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.

9. The Procuring Entity reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance

with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.

Eligibility Requirements

Legal Documents

Class “A” Documents:

- (i) PhilGEPS Certificate of Registration and Membership in accordance with Section 8.5.2 of the IRR
- (ii) Statement of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid; and

Statement of the Bidder’s SLCC similar to the contract to be bid, in accordance with ITB Clause 5.4, within two years. The two statements required shall indicate for each contract the following:

- (ii.1) name of the contract;
 - (ii.2) date of the contract;
 - (ii.3) contract duration;
 - (ii.4) owner’s name and address;
 - (ii.5) kinds of Goods;
 - (ii.6) For Statement of Ongoing Contracts - amount of contract and value of outstanding contracts;
 - (ii.7) For Statement of SLCC - amount of completed contracts, adjusted by the Bidder to current prices using PSA’s consumer price index, if necessary for the purpose of meeting the SLCC requirement;
 - (ii.8) date of delivery; and
 - (ii.9) end user’s acceptance or official receipt(s) or sales invoice issued for the contract, if completed, which shall be attached to the statements.
- (iii) NFCC computation in accordance with ITB Clause 5.5 or a committed Line of Credit from a universal or commercial bank.

Class “B” Document:

- (iv) If applicable, the Joint Venture Agreement (JVA) in case the joint venture is already in existence, or duly notarized statements from all the potential joint venture partners in accordance with Section 23.1(b) of the IRR.
